




Housing Units by Construction Date: County-Level Census Data from 1970




Housing Units by County: Census Data from 1940 and 1970





Rental Values by County: Census Data from 1940 and 1970





White and Non-White Population:


Modern-period Expansion in Ohio Illustrated for

Using Historical Highway Maps from 1945 and 1955








1941 Plat Map for Colonial Hills Neighborhood in Worthington


1956 Classification Map of Ohio State Highway System




Township Population Density 1960-1980-2000 People Per Square Mile





Land Uses in Ohio as of 1997




Map of Ohio State Forests and District Contacts




Comparison of Urban Sprawl in Ohio, 1960 and 2000
(Nikolic 2004:4)








Land Cover in Ohio, 1997








Ohio Urban Sprawl 1960
