PHOTOGRAPHING VISUAL PREFERENCES

AUTHOR: CAROL TRUPPI

By taking photographs, members of the three regional working groups for the Corridor Management Planning process can record special places and landscape features to express visual preferences about The National Road in Ohio. This activity gives you an opportunity “to vote with your eyes” and to become more aware of what you value about the National Road in your community.

OBJECTIVES

- To record visual preferences of the National Road through photography.
- To identify what you consider “special” in your community.
- To compare opinions about particular features of the National Road with others.

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Single lens reflex (SLR) cameras with a 35- or 50- mm lens are preferred.
- 100-200 ASA color film.
- A road or topographic map of your community.
- Photographer’s Diary Forms. (included with survey instructions)

COST

- \$5 - 25 for film and photographic processing. (Note: One roll of film could be used by several members of the regional working group to minimize the cost per person.)

OUTCOME / RESULTS

- A photographic inventory of scenic resources, landscape features, and community characteristics that are important to local citizens.
- Community Picture Boards showing photographs taken by participants for public meetings.

METHOD AND PROCEDURES

STEP I: PROCEDURES

1. We encourage you to write comments about why you took a particular photograph. What influenced your choice of a particular building, landscape, or natural feature over another? These comments will help everyone understand how visual features contribute to or detract from the National Road experience.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

2. Enclosed is a copy of a map, the Photographer's Diary Form and an attachment on Helpful Tips on Photography. If you choose to use a disposable camera, please identify the camera with your name. Everyone should put their name or organization on the map and diary form.
3. Return photographs, maps and diary forms to HRG Consultants, Inc. If you are sending photographs, it is critical that you number the photographs with the corresponding diary form number.

STEP II: FIELD TRIP – TAKE PHOTOGRAPHS

May be taken in one day or over a period of time (e.g., weeks)

1. Take photographs while driving or walking on errands, or arrange to shoot all the photos at once. Try to photograph on a day that will bring out the best in your scenes. There are advantages to shooting at different times of day and under different lighting conditions. For example, on a sunny day the sky may be blue and your subject brightly illuminated, but the contrast between light and shadow may obscure important details. Midday sun will give you good illumination without shades and shadows that appear early and late in the day but may flatten the scene. On a cloudy day, your subject will be more evenly lit, but the sky may be gray. In any photograph, compose the landscape in the viewfinder and focus clearly for good results.
2. Record the number each photograph on the diary form and the map to show the location from which the photograph was taken. Write comments about why the photograph was taken.

STEP III: PREPARE THE COMMUNITY PICTURE BOARDS

HRG will sort and chart photographs

1. The photographs will be sorted by survey categories, listed on the Photographer's Diary Form. The frequency count will be determined by how often a setting or feature was taken.
2. HRG, using the chart below, will count how often a feature or view was photographed for each category.
3. For the places most frequently photographed, HRG will then choose those photographs that best represent each place, to be displayed at public meetings.
