The Ohio State Historic Preservation Office currently uses Esri's Survey123 to intake and manage Ohio Archaeological Inventory (OAI) and Ohio Historic Inventory (OHI) forms.

Subscription Overview



No Subscription Required

Currently, access to complete OHI Forms is unlocked - a subscription to the OMS is not required.



Subscription Required

Access to OAI Entry Forms require an active Creator-level OMS subscription. This subscription allows users to view and edit data from any device.





Beginning Entry Forms



Landing Page


All entry forms associated with your account or device appear on the landing page.





Beginning a Form

Accessing an entry form will present you with a number of options (see *Understanding Survey123 Boxes* for more information) at the bottom of the window. To begin a new form, select *Collect*.



Understanding Survey123 Boxes



Sent box

Contains all forms submitted to SHPO from the local device.




Inbox

Contains all forms submitted to SHPO from the user's account.




Drafts

Contains incomplete surveys that are still being edited by the user.



Outbox

Contains completed forms not yet submitted to SHPO for review.



Overview

Aggregates all survey records currently stored within Outbox and Inbox (OAI) / Sent box (OHI).

Saving Forms as Drafts



Close Survey


At any time, click the 'x' in the top left corner to close the survey.



Survey Completed


When all required fields are complete, select the check mark at the bottom right corner of the form.

Frequently Asked Questions



While downloading the OAI Entry Form, I receive a "survey not found" error.

Before downloading the OAI Entry Form, ensure you are logged into Survey123 using your OMS account.



While accessing Survey123, I receive a "this user has no permissions" error.

Ensure your OMS subscription grants you Creator access and is active. If your OMS subscription is valid, please close out of Survey123 to refresh your connection.



I would like to QA/QC forms completed by supervised staff, how can I do this?

OAI: Please contact the <u>Archaeology</u> <u>Survey & Data Manager</u> for more information on reviewing OAI forms.

OHI: Unsubmitted OHI forms can be reviewed on the user's device. Submitted OHI forms can be reviewed using the OMS website.
