Administration

Appointed by the governor to carry out functions assigned to the state under the National Historic Preservation Act. The State Historic Preservation Officer is responsible for operations of the State Historic Preservation Office, including GIS and online applications for the office. Manages Historic Preservation Fund, Certified Local Governments subgrants, Ohio History Fund Grant Program, and other grants and contracts awarded to the office. Administers the Certified Local Governments program. Coordinates social media/outreach, annual State Historic Preservation Office Awards program and Building Doctor clinics. Oversees preparation of the statewide plan for historic preservation.

Inventory & Registration

Administers the National Register of Historic Places program in Ohio, and manages the Ohio Historic Inventory, and Ohio Archaeological Inventory.

Technical Preservation Services

Works with applicants seeking federal and state rehabilitation tax credits. Advises on the physical conservation of historic properties. Serves as liaison to national and statewide historic preservation organizations.

Resource Protection and Review

Reviews federally-funded or -licensed projects in Ohio for effects on historic properties included in, or eligible for, the National Register of Historic Places, as required under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. Reviews state-funded projects in accordance with Section 149.53 of the Ohio Revised Code.
