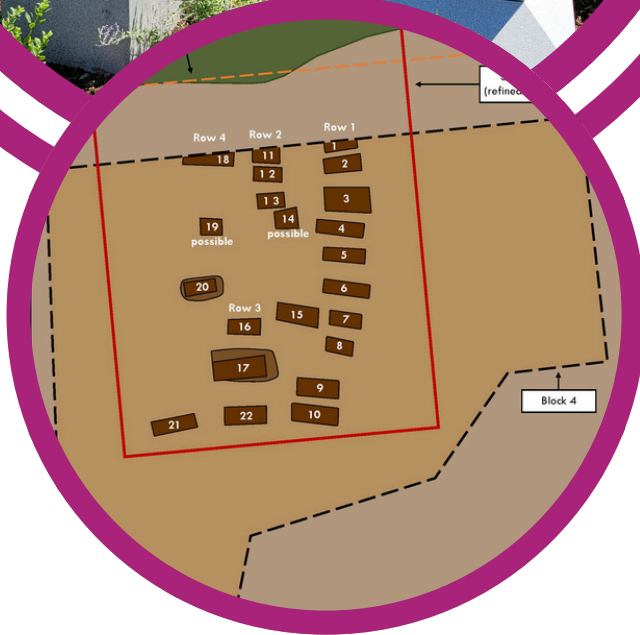

PRESERVING OUR PAST, PROTECTING OUR FUTURE

Dublin, Franklin County

The Brown-Harris Cemetery, a lost African American burial site, was discovered in 2020 during archaeological investigations for the University Boulevard Project and The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center Outpatient Care Dublin Facility.

It contains 22 burials from an African American settlement in Washington Township from the 1830s to 1915. With support from Brown and Harris family descendants, the City of Dublin, the State Historic Preservation Office, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers preserved the cemetery, dedicating it on June 28, 2024.
